Clinica Colorado is a nonprofit Primary Care Clinic. Our mission is to provide low cost healthcare for those who are indigent, without health insurance or unable to obtain primary care services. Our vision is to have affordable healthcare available to all residents of Colorado.

Compensation includes a competitive base salary commensurate with work experience. Benefits include organization-sponsored health insurance stipend, malpractice coverage, paid-time-off, annual CME reimbursement, and an employer match on SIMPLE IRA retirement plans. Other voluntary benefits include AFLAC insurance.

Loan repayment opportunities are available through the National Health Service Corps and the Colorado Health Service Corps programs. The Health Professional Shortage Population Area is 12, per HRSA.

A majority of our patients are uninsured, and many are monolingual Spanish speakers. Dedication to caring for underserved populations is a key requirement for this position.
